

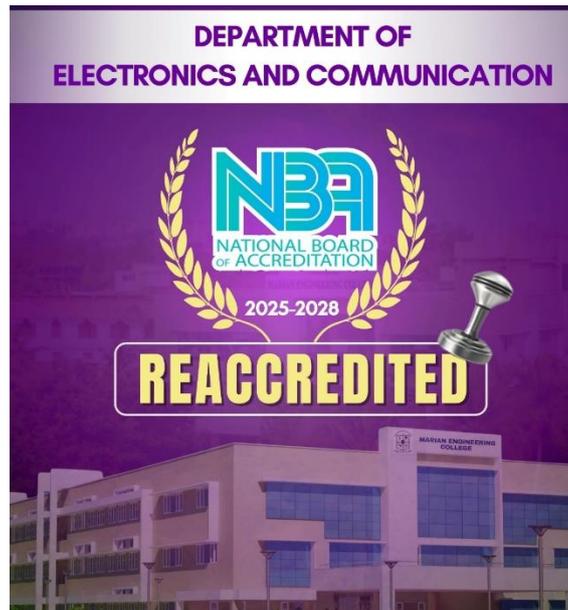
# DEPARTMENT ACHIEVEMENTS

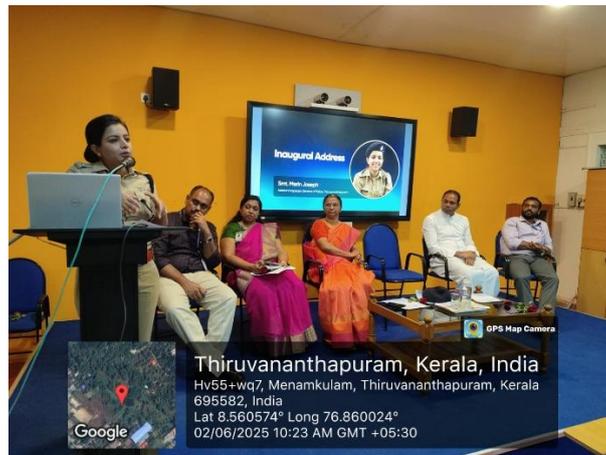


## DEPARTMENT ACTIVITIES

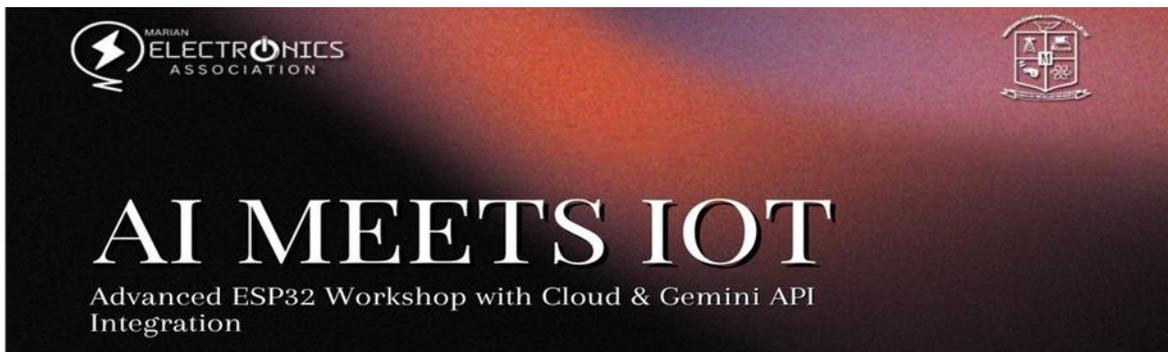

2. Intercollegiate student Paper Presentation Contest based on themes related to EMBS. Eight teams had participated.



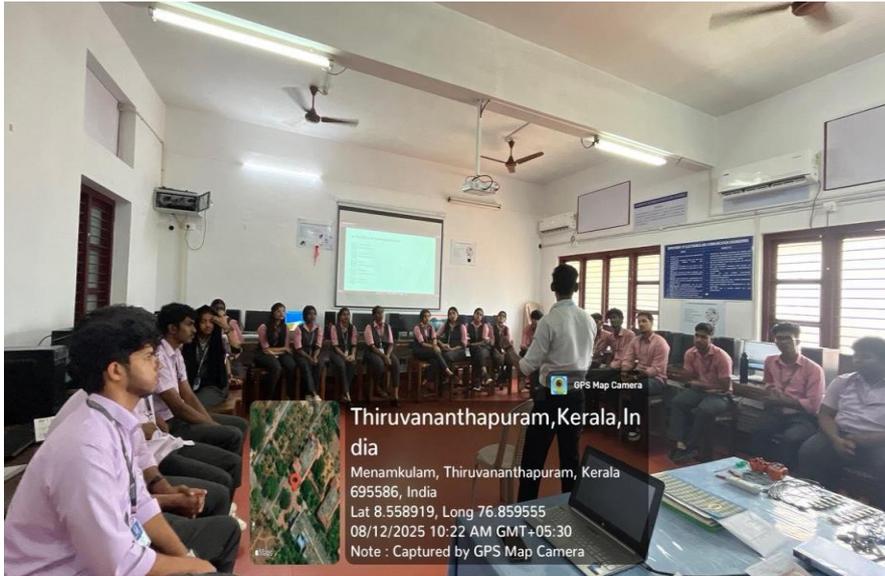

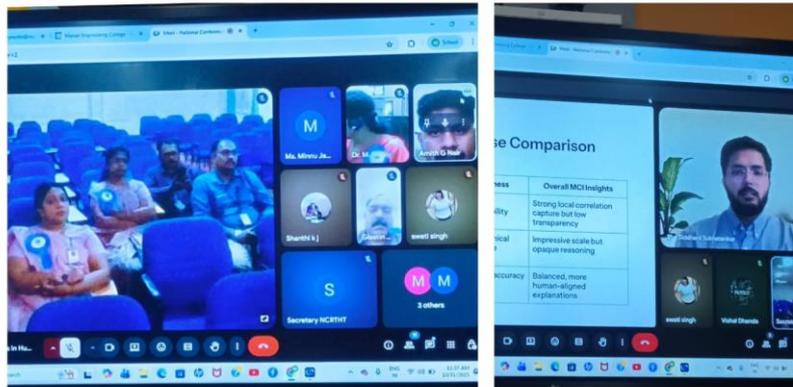
